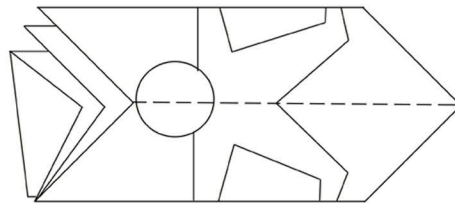


**“And as ye would

1. Fold a rectangular sheet of paper in half three times. Draw a doll centered on the outside of the last fold, with arms and feet extending to the paper's edges.



2. With paper fully folded, cut around one-half of the outline. This makes four dolls joined at the hands and feet.



3. make a set of dolls for each child, and have the children color in their own dolls as they wish. suggest that they may wish to give the dolls different racial features and ethnic dress. Give them the opportunity to tell about the dolls they have colored.
